



OSHA's hazard communication standard (29 CFR 1910.1200), requires businesses that use or store hazardous chemicals to train their employees on changes to chemical labels and safety data sheets by December 1, 2013. Failure to comply with OSHA's hazard communication standard, including mandatory training requirements, can result in fines up to \$7,000 per violation. 
